MINUTES OF THE 2024 AGM @ COULSDON CLUB

8TH SEPTEMBER 2024

1. Attendees and apologies for absences

2. Treasurer report

Tim and Max are currently managing the League bank account. Mick will be taking on Treasurer responsibilities, with an appropriate handover taking place. The bank account remains solvent, with c.£900 carried forward from last season, c.£600 spent on trophies and engraving, and team entry fees coming in for the 2024-25 season.

3. Election of officers

Max Burt elected as Secretary in advance of the AGM. Tim Mander remaining as President. Mick Davies to take on role of Treasurer.

4. Registration and welcome to new teams

Registrations were received by all teams represented at the AGM

5. League format/dates

Currently 6 teams entered, with Frames C and Comrades D trying to source replacement players in order to enter their respective teams (please reach out if you're interested in playing for either of these teams, and please pass the message onto other people you know that are snooker regulars in the area).

League start date TBC, expected to be late September/early October, will aim to ensure league fixtures continue well into March.

If 6 teams enter, teams will play each other four times (twice home, twice away).

If 7 or 8 teams, teams will play each other three times (once home, once away, other will be random draw).

If 9+ teams, teams will play each other twice (once home, once away).

League Finals Day date TBC based on release of league fixtures, expected to be late March/April.

6. 6 reds competition

Plans to hold a 6 reds competition this side of Christmas. Suggestion of holding it on a Wednesday night (or a Sunday afternoon/evening if lots of entries), date TBC based on release of league fixtures and number of entries. Max to arrange suitable venue. £10 entry fee agreed, cash prize for 1st/2nd. Committee to consider level of cash prize. Competition format to be determined based on number of entries. Competition open to both league and non-league players. Handicap system to be used based on career averages (% frames won) in the Reigate league. Non-league players will have no handicap.

7. Any other business

Point raised around deadlines for individual competitions. Individuals are responsible for meeting deadlines, they can refer to the website or speak to team captains if they're unsure of deadlines. Max will also send round reminders on WhatsApp during the season. Individuals should make note of the date for Finals Day and ensure they will be available on this date.

Point raised around managing teams which postpone league matches on a regular basis, we will refer to the league rules and provide confirmation of the approach that will be taken on postponed fixtures in due course.

Point raised around responsibility for looking after trophies. Burgess Cup, League trophy and Team Knockout trophy with Lewis Allen (Woldingham). Charles Hill Cup with Tony Mansfield. Burgess Plate with Max Burt. Winchester Pairs trophy with Max Burt - to give to Evan Plummer.
